



"I personally see 'Made in America' and 'Fair Trade' as complementary movements, not necessarily competitive," said Kroh. "Fair trade places an emphasis on the rights and dignity of human beings. In my view the principles of fair trade should remain relevant regardless of geography. All people, whether in the Global North or South, deserve dignified working conditions and equitable trade relationships. The specifics of each case may vary around the world, but the core ideals of fairness and equality remain the same."

"We're all friends," added Kelly Weinberger of WorldFinds. "I think that all our missions are to create a better world through the products that we're sourcing."

Industry's cutting-edge green products recognized as Eco Choice winners at summer edition of NY Now.

Summer in New York City brought NY NOW back to the Javits Center. Several eco-conscious products were part of the show's SustainAbility display with the best among them being nominated for and winning the coveted Eco-Choice Awards. The awards are sponsored by NY Now and GREENRetailer magazine.

The SustainAbility display trains the spotlight on green gift and home products. In 2010, NY NOW raised the bar and created a criteria system with ranking codes–SustainAbility1 through SustainAbility3, the top-ranking 'Degree of SustainAbility' to indicate the extent to which a product or company meets standards of eco-friendly production practices and materials, fair trade specifications, socially responsible business practices, philanthropy, and other eco-smart indicators. The SustainAbility display is a curated exhibit of products that meets the highest standards of eco-consciousness.

In that vast field of eye-catching, inspiring gift and lifestyle items, just a handful of eco-friendly products were up for online balloting to win elite Eco-Choice Awards in the categories of Most Innovative, Most Sensitive Use of Materials, and Most Sellable

"These companies represent multiple product categories, but all are committed to running sustainable, socially-conscious businesses," said Christian Falkenberg, NY NOW director and



GLM senior vice president. "From 10 finalists in each of the three competition categories, these eco-friendly products were determined as winners by popular vote."

"As environmentally conscious gifts become increasingly sought after and even expected, these products show us that the definition of green has been changing over the years," said Patricia Norins, publisher of GREENRetailer, "They are trendy and edgy – the best combination of function and form. Recycled Kantha Wrap Bracelet From WorldFinds (Westmont, IL)

This fair-trade bracelet is handmade from repurposed Kantha quilts and scraps left over from making larger bags. Textile ribbons are wrapped and twisted for a unique layered look. Worldfinds' founder and president Kelly Weinberger says the bracelets make for an excellent store display since they are available in assorted colors and patterns.

Each bracelet measures 28 %" long x 5/8" wide, is finished with a hammered brass hoop and lobster clasp closure. The bracelets are made in India by low-income women artisans working in a cooperative.

Weinberger says the Eco Choice award is great for bringing attention to themselves as a small company, and to spread the word about fair trade jewelry overall. "Hopefully, this will bring even more fair trade jewelry to the market," she says.


