Innovations that Create Economic Opportunities

Fair trade enterprises place the interests of producers and their communities as the primary concern of their enterprise.

WorldFinds has a holistic business approach in which all are paid a living wage, have safe working conditions, access to healthcare and childcare, and on-going training and education. They have been working with many groups for over a decade, during which many artisans have lifted themselves out of poverty and even launch their own successful businesses. For World Fair Trade Day, WorldFinds is working with their artisans partners to launch a new collection of bracelets. The Cause Connection Bracelets are delicately beaded, stretchy styles each connected to a cause. The causes they benefit include funding cancer research, educating girls, cleaning oceans, empowering women, rescuing animals, providing meals, supporting U.S. veterans, and promoting equality.

Dunitz & Company supports the fair trade community through actively raising awareness about fair trade and FTF members. They are helping to promote fair trade through on-going blog writing, directing buyers to many fair trade enterprises. Without sales, these businesses cannot do what they do best: sustaining the artisans and farmers they've worked with for so many years.
